The purpose of the in-person/virtual public hearing is to gather citizen input on the *Draft 2024 Annual Action Plan for Housing and Community Development in Suburban Monroe County* and the proposed projects described therein.

Monroe County expects to receive an allocation of \$3,059,601 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in 2024. This amount represents allocations for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in the amount of \$1,685,167, the HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) in the amount of \$1,213,447 and the Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) in the amount of \$160,987. Estimated program income is \$110,000 for the CDBG program and \$121,324 for the HOME program. When all sources of funds are combined, the total amount available for the CDBG, HOME, and ESG 2024-25 programs will be approximately \$3,290,925. Monroe County and HUD are not bound by these estimates as they are subject to final approval of the program submissions by HUD.

In accordance with federal regulations, the *Draft 2024 Annual Action Plan for Housing and Community Development in Suburban Monroe County* presents a strategic framework for community development, affordable housing and home ownership programs in Monroe County. The meeting will outline the strategy that Monroe County has put together for the CDBG, HOME and ESG programs. This will include discussing community development needs, proposed projects, the cost of projects, and the goals and objectives of the CDBG program.

The program categories and estimated funding levels proposed for the period of August 1, 2024 through July 31, 2025 are listed below and are detailed in the Draft 2024 Annual Action Plan for Housing and Community Development in Suburban Monroe County.
