**Raheim Robinson Convicted of Multiple Counts of Murder in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree**

Rochester, NY- On March 29, 2024, 21-year-old Raheim Robinson was convicted by a jury of all counts including, four counts of Murder in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, twelve counts of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, Attempted Murder in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, Reckless Endangerment in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, and Arson in the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree for violent acts committed on July 19 and July 20, 2022, which resulted in the deaths of Richard Collinge and MyJel Rand.

On the night of July 19, 2022, Rochester Police Officers arrived near North Clinton Avenue and Rauber Street for multiple gunshots in the area, including those that hit a house and vehicle.

On July 20, 2022, at approximately 12:30AM, Richard Collinge, MyJel Rand, and Tireek Burden were gunned down in the City of Rochester near North Clinton Avenue and Rauber Street. Following the gunshots, Rochester Police Officers arrived on scene, where Richard Collinge was pronounced dead. MyJel Rand and Tireek Burden were immediately transported to Strong Memorial Hospital, where MyJel died from his gunshot wounds.

Later in the early morning hours, a fire on Weyl Street in the City of Rochester was reported. A car was engulfed in flames, which began spreading to a nearby house. The Rochester Fire Department responded and put out the fire.

As the investigation continued, the evidence showed that 34-year-old Deadrick Fulwiley and Raheim Robinson were responsible for the murders of Richard Collinge, MyJel Rand, the attempted murder of Tireek Burden, and were also responsible for the arson of the vehicle that same day. They were charged for the murders and surrounding events.

On March 12, 2024, Deadrick Fulwiley pled guilty to two counts of Murder in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree and Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree for the murders of Richard Collinge and MyJel Rand. He will be sentenced to 30 years to Life in the New York State Department of Corrections.

23-year-old Kelvin Vickers was also arrested for the murders of Richard Collinge and MyJel Rand. During the course of the investigation, Kelvin Vickers murdered Rochester Police Officer Anthony Mazurkiewicz and shot Rochester Police Officer Sino Seng. He was convicted for all three murders, and over a dozen other felony charges, and was sentenced to consecutive terms of Life Without the Possibility of Parole sentences.

The case was prosecuted by First Assistant District Attorney Perry Duckles.

“Raheim Robinson and Deadrick Fulwiley participated in a violent crime spree that involved the brutal murders of Richard Collinge and MyJel Rand,” said First Assistant District Attorney Perry Duckles. “Neither defendant considered the value of human life when they made the choice to murder these two young men, which led to events involving the murder of Officer Mazurkiewicz at the hands of Kelvin Vickers. I am pleased that both Raheim Robinson and Deadrick Fulwiley will be held accountable for their actions and may spend the rest of their lives in the New York State Department of Corrections. After so much heartache for the families of Richard Collinge and MyJel Rand, it is my hope that today’s conviction will finally bring a feeling of justice for their loved ones.”

“Involved in days of nonstop violence, Raheim Robinson and Deadrick Fulwiley terrorized the community with gun violence, arson, and murder,” said Monroe County District Attorney Sandra Doorley. “I want to thank the Rochester Police Department for putting as much work into finding justice for Richard Collinge and MyJel Rand, as they did for their fallen brother, Officer Mazurkiewicz. As a danger to us all, both Raheim Robinson and Deadrick Fulwiley deserve to spend the remainder of their days in custody. It is my hope that both of these men consider Richard Collinge and MyJel Rand, the young lives stolen from their families.”

Raheim Robinson will be sentenced on May 31, 2024, in front of Monroe County Court Judge Julie Hahn. Deadrick Fulwiley will be sentenced on May 17, 2024, also in front of Monroe County Court Judge Julie Hahn.
